The Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability) is Australia's leading disability course.

The course is for those who want to:

Throughout the course, students will develop a range of essential skills that will assist them to provide better care for people living with mental or physical disabilities. The course teaches students the skills to empower and support people with disabilities, whilst also learning how to provide appropriate home and community support. Students will also understand legal and ethical workplace practices that help facilitate responsible behaviour.

Why an Internship?

Our internship option is a combination of placement work and study. This option is ideal for students who are looking for paid work while they study with have no course fees.

An internship will provide you with a **minimum** of 15 hours per week at an allocated employer, which allows you to apply the knowledge that you are learning from your studies into your work role. You will receive a competitive internship wage as well as leave entitlements and study allowances. You will be matched with an industry professional who will be able to guide you through your placement and if you are not happy with your allocated employer, you can move to find one that better suits your needs.

As for studying there will be ongoing support to help you through the course by dedicated trainers with extensive experience in the industry.

An internship is a great way to try out a new industry, guarantee work hours in an industry you are already in, and it also boasts a very high employment rate on course completion.

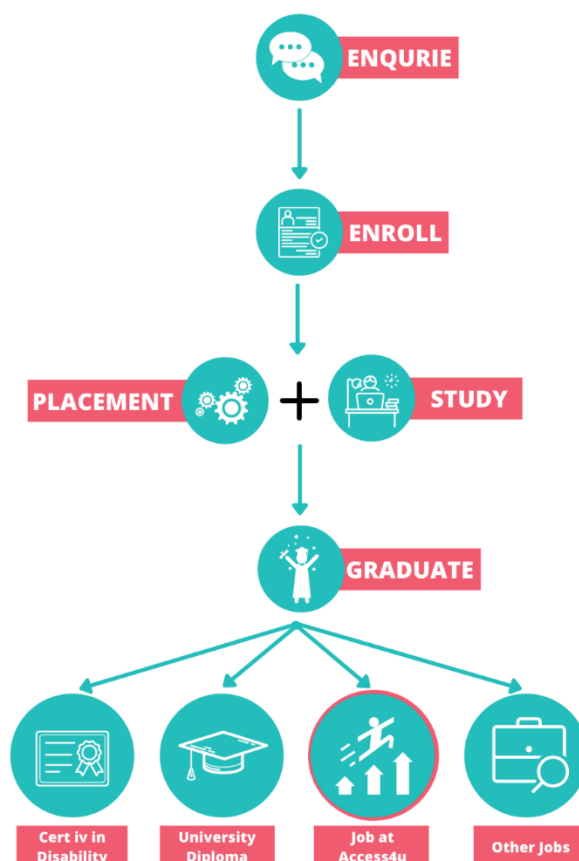
Study Location
