

Mentor Dress Code Guide

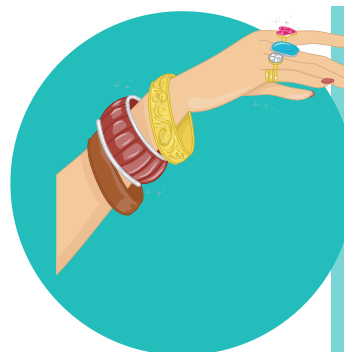
At Access4u, our staff commit to dressing appropriately and professionally to undertake their duties safely and be a positive representation of the organisation.



Hair should be clean, neat and professional.



A hat, sunscreen, protective clothing and eyewear should be worn when exposed to UV levels of 3 or above.



Jewellery and accessories

should be minimal and not sharp, heavy or have the ability to poke or hit another person while wearing, to ensure the safety of other staff and customers.



Tops and t-shirts

must be modest, professional, and sensitive to customers. Avoid low/revealing tops, short tops that show midriff, and loose or minimal singlets. Ensure any graphic or text is professional and not offensive, profane, or able to be interpreted as such.

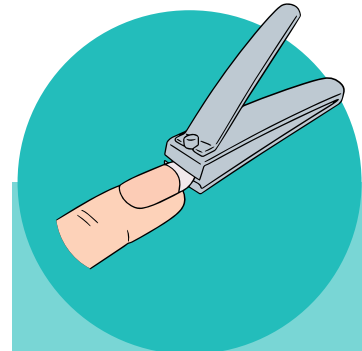


Shoes must be enclosed and sturdy, must cover your toes, and be secure to the foot. Birkenstocks, thongs, sandals, slides, or any other open-toed or loosely fitted shoes are not permitted.



Pants and bottoms

must be modest, professional, and mobile. Ensure attire remains this way when walking/bending/running/sitting. Avoid items that are short, overly tight or revealing.



Fingernails

should be kept short and clean. Acrylics/nail extensions must be minimal in length and cannot be sharp or pointed to avoid injury.
