My name's Nathan. I've been with Access4u for a year and a half now, or just under it. And have been just enjoying every bit of it since I started.

So, when I started at Access4u, the team said there was this pathway through CEG, to get the Cert III (CHC33021 in Individual Support – Disability), and they said that if I wanted to further my career in the sector, that it was a good idea – so, (I) loved what they were doing, and I went for it.

As a mentor at Access4u, I try and help out as much as I can, with what the client wants – and try and improve their lifestyle, gain confidence for themselves, show them how things work, and try and get them more independent, and see if they can hit their goals that they aim for.

The flexibility (in the Cert III) is great, the information I get is laid out all in front of me. With the study – it's quite flexible; I'm able to do other hobbies and play baseball all the time. So, sometimes I leave on a Thursday and come back Sundays, and then whenever I have free time during the days or even late at night, I'm able to jump on the program that I'm on and do my work for it. They're always messaging me asking how it's going, if I need any help.

I'd say anyone can do it (Disability Mentoring). It's quite easy to get a grasp of what to do, and there's always the chance of going further down the pathway, if you wanted to.
